Our integrated learning approach is an activity based learning process where experimentation, self-discovery, high level of engagement and hands-on experience are given priority.

Personal, academic, social and emotional development is given importance over basic cognitive development, ensuring that reasoning is not neglected. All learners attend compulsory computer literacy classes which teach them basic end user computer skills such as typing, MS Word, Excel, Power point and Internet surfing from grade R-12.

Project based IT classes with certificates awarded at the end of each semester (end of the project) for learners from grade R-12 where they learn about in-depth computer skills like coding, developing web pages, apps and databases are however optional.

Academic enrichment programs like Chess, Spelling Bee, Quiz, Art and Craft, Role Plays and Debate are impressed upon the learners to boost their IQ and self-esteem. This interdisciplinary approach creates eager and active learning skills in students and ensures their overall development.

Admission Procedure (talk About Foreign Students)

Our values of discipline make SPA an ideal place for students to excel in academics and achieve all-round development. We aim to inspire them through our pattern of holistic education. The admission procedure is completely transparent and follows rules meticulously laid for the purpose.

Admission Policy

An application form dully filled and submitted along with necessary documentation. Originals may be requested for verification.

Admission Requirements Include:

- A completed Registration/enrolment contract form
- Two recent ID photos of the child (Head & Shoulders)
- A copy of your child's ID book or Birth Certificate
- A copy of the parent's/ guardian's ID document.
- Most recent previous Report Card or results
- A transfer letter/Card where this is applicable
- Proof of your residential address
- A signed declaration that you have read, understood and agreed to code of conduct as indicated in the learner handbook.

Admission is not based solely on academic achievement but also on our assessment of how well the applicant is likely to adapt to our curriculum and school life. A prospective learner should not be a social or moral liability to other learners or the school. The Management of SOUTHAMPTON PRIVATE ACADEMY views all applications in strict confidence and is not obliged to give reasons for refusing any application.

Parents as well as the prospective learner must subscribe to and adhere to the School Code of conduct, and must accept that these are the guiding philosophies in our approach to education.

An interview with the Principal or Phase Head of Department and the prospective learner and his/her parents may be requested prior to admission. The prospective learner may be subject to a Mathematics and/or English Test before admission.





Withdrawal procedure:

- The registration fee is non-refundable upon withdrawal of child soon after admission.
- A one month notice should be submitted in writing to the administration's office before the child can be withdrawn.
- Should the child be withdrawn in the course of the month, the full month fee will be charged.
- All outstanding fees must be paid and original receipt submitted to the administration's office before a transfer letter can be issued.
- Payments for study materials shall not be refundable regardless of whether the materials have been collected by the student or not from the college. This will be the case whenever the book order has already been processed.

LILY MDUTYANA (GRADE 8)


